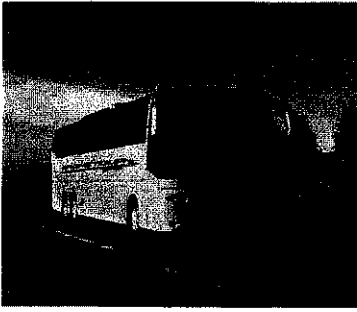

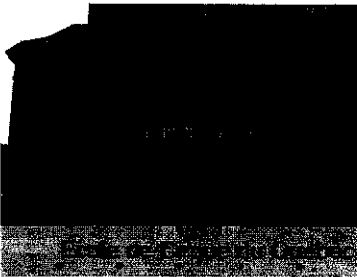

- Departure from your school to Quebec City
- Meet your **Quebecois Prometour Tour Director** upon arrival, he/she will remain with your group for the entire duration of your stay
- At **Immersion Quebec**, with the help of a virtual reality headset, Quebec's history will be revealed thanks to 3D animation techniques and a friendly competition of knowledge, skills and speed. Then, create a personalized historical avatar and interact with the terminals scattered throughout the room

DAY 2: QUEBEC CITY

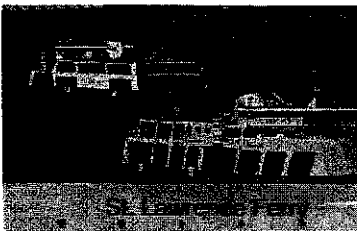
Thursday 30-Apr-2020

- At **Parc de la Chute Montmorency** have time for photos, to walk over the suspended bridge, and take the 487 steps for a different view of the falls which are higher than those of Niagara Falls
- Drive out to La Beauce, the maple syrup capital of the world, to enjoy a traditional sugar shack meal and learn traditional dances and folk songs at the famed **Cabane à Pierre Sugar Shack**

DAY 3: QUEBEC CITY

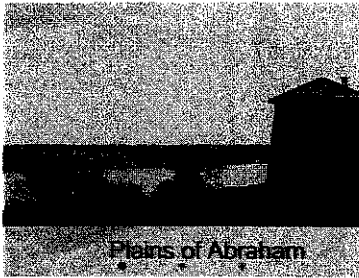
Friday 01-May-2020

MAKING PAYMENT

Forms to be returned:

(forms will be distributed after student is registered)

1. Completed medical form : to be returned to nurse by January 4, 2020
2. Permission slip: to be returned to Mrs. Plante by January 4, 2020
3. Students traveling should bring in original long form birth certificate or valid passport to Mrs. Plante 30 days by March 25, 2020
4. Adults traveling should send in a copy of Passport by March 25, 2020 and hold on to the original (However, make sure to bring with you when we go!)

Travel Documents:

Students under the age of 18 do not need a passport, only a long form birth certificate (which I will keep safe) but should bring their school issue ID card with them to present at border crossing.

Adults traveling must have a valid Passport. I will hold a copy safe with the student's birth certificates/passports.
