Our medical advisor approved the administration of the following oral medications to your child only when written permission has been received. These medications will be given by the school nurse in accordance with the School Board Policy.

- ◆ Tylenol- relieve pain, fever
- ◆ Ibuprofen- relieve pain, fever, inflammation
- ◆ Tums- antacid for stomach upset

Also used are the following products for which parental permission is implied:

- ◆ Caladryl lotion- poison ivy, mosquito bites, itchy rashes
- ◆ Bacitracin lotion- prevention of infections in scrapes, cuts and burns
- ◆ Bactine lotion- scrapes and cuts
- ◆ Vaseline petroleum jelly- chapped lips
